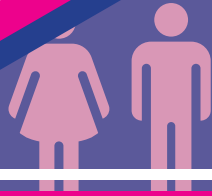
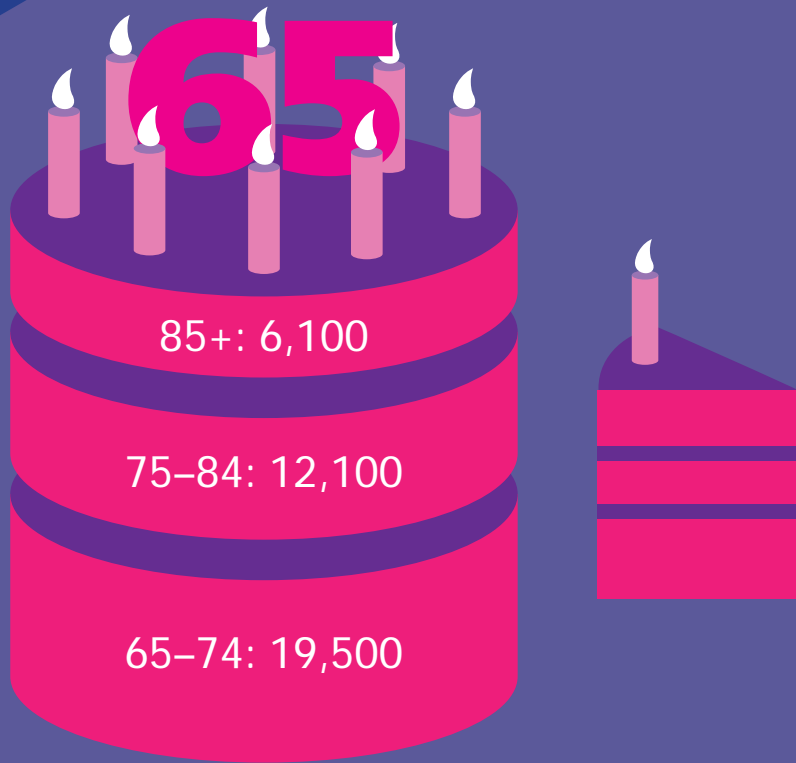

HEALTH AND WELLBEING ISSUES FOR OLDER PEOPLE IN BRIGHTON & HOVE

Majority of those aged 50 and over are in poor health

Over half of those aged 65 and over (19,000) find their day-to-day activities limited

1% of those aged 50 and over are carers

There are 11,500 carers aged 50 and over

14,400 people aged 50 and over live in 'non-decent homes'
